**Price:** \$160 per player

**Includes:** Green fee, power cart, unlimited use of driving range, dinner, access to the auction and a no-host awards reception. Golfers are responsible for club rentals. We will group you with other participants if you do not have a full foursome to play with.

### COMPETITION RULES

Players may register as an individual or a two, three or four person team. The committee will group singles, doubles and triples with other participants as necessary.

Ladies play from the green tee markers and men play from the blue tee markers.

All team members tee off and select the tee shot to be used by the team.

Everyone plays their own ball on each hole and through the green (until holing out).

## WOMEN'S HEARTH

A one-of-a-kind downtown day center for women providing community, activities, social service referrals and classes. Participants also have access to telephones, computers, internet, healthy food, hygiene supplies, free showers and a respite room.

### IN 2017:

- 1,523 women served
- 16,596 visits completed
- 50 women obtained housing



## MIRYAM'S HOUSE

Transitional housing in a community setting for 9 homeless women without children plus one permanent housing apartment for a woman ready to live independently. Includes on-site counseling, life-skills and continuing support for alumnae.

### IN 2017:

- 22 women served
- 9 women obtained housing
- 3 women obtained employment
- 2 women advanced their education



## EDUCARE

Licensed childcare on the TLC campus for toddlers, preschool and school-age children designed to meet the needs of formerly homeless children.

### IN 2017:

- 18 children received supportive care
- 1,705 meals were served
- 4,397 hours provided for childcare



## NEW LEAF BAKERY CAFÉ

Job training in the food services industry for women with barriers to employment. Hands-on training is offered in a fast-paced commercial kitchen providing catering services, with separate barista training at our full service café. Agency-wide job readiness support is also provided.

### IN 2017:

- 43 women received job training
- 28 women obtained employment
- 17 women advanced their education



## TRANSITIONAL LIVING CENTER

Transitional housing with support services for homeless women and their children in 15 apartments and one permanent housing unit on a park-like campus. This program includes on-site counseling, support groups and parenting education classes.

### IN 2017:

- 20 families with 54 children served
- 4 moms advanced their education
- 1 family obtained housing

## HOME YARD COTTAGES

Affordable, permanent housing units for families and individuals in 24 cottages, with support services, playground, raised garden beds, and ultra-efficient units. **Opening October 2018**
