



Fundraiser Tips Sheet

Considering being jailed and bailed for Transitions? Here's what you need to know!

1. Transitions is a local non-profit that works to end poverty and homelessness for women and children in Spokane. Each year we fundraiser to support our FIVE programs. Last year we lost \$300,000 in federal dollars. We are asking you to help fill that budget shortfall with a one-time participation in Jailed and Bailed for Transitions.
2. You will be jailed at the Transitional Living Center at 3128 N Hemlock starting at 8:00 a.m. on May 17th. Your sentence will be determined by your ability to post bail at: \$800, \$1,000 or \$1,200.
3. You are due to arrive at 8:00 a.m. and will be incarcerated with access to only basic needs: food, coffee, and restroom.
4. Bring your cell phone and contact list. You will be contacting your group of friends, family and associates to post bail.
 - a. Let your network know you will need their help May 17th!
 - b. They can pay by credit card, processed by office staff
 - c. They can pay by check – however you are responsible for picking that check up and bringing it back to “jail.”
 - d. Gifts of any amount are allowed!
5. We will be taking and posting photos of the event on social media and our website, we also hope to receive press coverage. You will be asked to wear a provided t-shirt so please let us know your t-shirt size in advance!
